FB-ISAO has assessed the general Physical Threat Level for US Faith-Based Organizations as "SEVERE." As per FB-ISAO's definitions of the Physical Threat Levels, "SEVERE" means that an event is highly likely.

Please note that the Pandemic Threat Level has been lowered to Guarded.

## FB-ISAO Cyber Threat Level:

Guarded

FB-ISAO has assessed the general Cyber Threat Level for US Faith-Based Organizations as "GUARDED." As per FB-ISAO's definitions of the Cyber Threat Levels, "GUARDED" means FB-ISAO is unaware of any specific events, but a general risk of incidents exists.

#### Adoption of TLP 2.0

Adoption of the Traffic Light Protocol (TLP) version 2.0. FB-ISAO adopted the TLP since its inception. In January of 2023, FB-ISAO will move over to TLP 2.0. You can learn more <a href="here">here</a>.

#### Changes to FB-ISAO Slack

The FB-ISAO Slack workspace will facilitate members' ability to find the information they need. We will be eliminating some channels, renaming some others, and adding new ones. We will be expanding on the use of prefixes to help delineate the type of information that is shared in individual channels. Current channel prefixes are:

- **g\_** for FB-ISAO Working Group channels. <u>Learn more about</u> working groups
- **isc\_** for Information Sharing Communities. <u>Learn more about Information Sharing Communities</u>
- pir\_ for information that falls under FB-ISAO's Priority Intelligence Requirements. <u>Learn more about Priority</u> <u>Intelligence Requirements</u>

Going forward we will add the following prefixes. We will also be adding some topical channels that align with those prefixes:

- ofb\_ for open-source intelligence information more likely pertinent to Faith-Based Organizations security operations.
- **og\_** for open-source intelligence information that is more general in nature but that may impact Faith-Based Organizations security operations.

# FB-ISAO Adopts Traffic Light Protocol 2.0

The community of faith is becoming more integrated into security operations. As such, security practitioners are communicating and collaborating by sharing threat intelligence and threat information. This sharing includes things like analytical reports, incident reports, and suspicious activity reports (SARs). Additionally, general reporting is shared in our collaborative workspace. As an organization, the Faith-Based Information Sharing and Analysis Organization (FB-ISAO) not only shares threat intelligence and information with its members, but across organizational boundaries as appropriate. This practice of information sharing is managed efficiently and coordinated well when all participants share one common information sharing protocol.

Since our inception in 2018, FB-ISAO adopted the Traffic Light Protocol 1.0, most commonly referred to simply as "TLP." TLP was conceptualized by the Forum of Incident Response and Security Teams (FIRST) to facilitate greater sharing of sensitive information. In August 2022, FIRST standardized the most current version, TLP 2.0. What is Traffic Light Protocol (TLP)?

The Traffic Light Protocol is an easy-to-understand and useful standard to govern information disclosure practices. TLP 2.0 provides more granular guidance over threat intelligence sharing and is intended to be more user-friendly than the previous version. Learn more about TLP. What are the changes from TLP 1.0 to TLP 2.0?

In summary, the TLP:WHITE designation has been renamed TLP:CLEAR in the latest standard. A new TLP:AMBER+STRICT designation has been added to highlight information that is restricted to the recipient's organization only. For the FB-ISAO Community, the greatest difference will be evident in the change from TLP:WHITE to TLP:CLEAR.

FB-ISAO will adopt TLP 2.0 in January 2023.
