

We are unique

- Faith-Based Organizations (FBOs) operate in a unique security environment. FBOs must maintain a welcoming approach and provide a safe environment for staff and congregants despite the lack the resources for a dedicated or even part-time security team.
- FB-ISAO members engage with leaders who are experiencing similar security challenges, they share effective practices and mitigation strategies, and learn from each other.
- Members also receive daily threat and analytical reports highlighting security challenges confronting FBOs, giving resource-constrained organizations insights, resources, best practices, and analysis that are hard to find.
- FB-ISAO membership extends the scope and capabilities of any organization's physical and cyber security risk management activities, like adding virtual staff members.



Our mission remains relevant

 In March 2023, a now-deceased individual shot and killed six people at a Christian elementary school in Nashville, Tennessee. Law enforcement continues to investigate the motive behind the attack and has indicated the individual studied other mass murderers.



 Also in March 2023, a RMVE driven by a belief in the superiority of the white race was arrested and charged with allegedly attempting to use an improvised incendiary device to burn down a church in Ohio that was planning to host a drag-themed event.

Summary of Terrorism-Related Threat to the United States

The United States remains in a heightened threat environment. Lone offenders and small groups motivated by a range of ideological beliefs and personal grievances continue to pose a persistent and tethal threat to the Homeland. Bolt domestic violent extremists (DVEs) and those associated with foreign terrorist organizations continue to attempt to motivate supporters to conduct attacks in the Homeland, including through violent extremist messaging and online calls for violence. In the coming months, factors that could mobilize individuals to commit violence include their perceptions of the 2024 general election cycle and legislative or judicial decisions pertaining to sociopolitical issues. Likely targets of potential violence include US critical infrastructure, faith-based institutions, individuals or events associated with the LGBTQA+ community, schools, racial and ethnic minorities, and government facilities and personnel, including law enforcement.


